Going Places

This half term our topic at school would have been 'Going Places'. Below are some projects and activity ideas you can do at home.

Read 'We're going on a bear hunt' or watch the video on YouTube. Go on your own 'bear hunt' and collect lots of different sticks and leaves. Use these to make a nature collage of you or your favourite animal.



Think about different modes of transport. Which ones have you been on? Can you make a car or aeroplane etc. out of an old cardboard box and paper plates for wheels and decorate it?



Think about different countries. Can you think of a hot country and a cold country? Pack a suitcase or a rucksack of things you would need if you were going to that country. Think about what you would need that's specific for a hot country and a cold country.

Make sure to write a tag for your suitcase or rucksack.



Can you think about some cold countries? What sort of animals do you think they have there?

Can you make your own iceberg? Fill a balloon with water and freeze it. You could add food colouring or toys to make it more fun! Can you make the ice melt faster?



Find an empty jar. Every time you go out can you find something you add to the jar? It could be a flower, a leaf, a stone, a coin, a shell etc. then bring it on to school when we are back so you can use it to show and tell us the different places you have been during your time at home. You could add words or photos to the jar for things that are really special.



Ask your grown-ups to take lots of photos and keep anything you make as we would love to see them when we come back to school.
