This term we would have been learning about animals at school.

Please also remember to do some of the daily English and Maths on BBC Bitesize. Just choose Y1 and off you go. There are different lessons every day with clips and activities to complete.

Make a list of different animals and categorise them depending on whether they're a zoo, farm or under the sea animal.	From your list of animals, choose your favourite one and explain why it is your favourite. Draw a picture of your favourite animal and label it.	Research what an herbivore, carnivore and omnivore is. Can you categorise your list of animals into those 3 categories?
Choose an animal and create a fact file sheet. Research the animal (ask a grown up to help you) and see what interesting facts you can find.	Create an animal mask. Have a look around your house and garden to see what resources you could use. This could include paper, cardboard boxes, milk cartons, leaves, feathers, grass. See how creative you can be.	Can you tell an adult a story about your favourite animal? Remember to include some adjectives. Write your story down, so you can share it with the class when you're back at school.
On Twinkl (using your log in details from your first pack) read the story 'A Tale of Two Feathers'. Retell the story to an adult.	Using the story 'A Tale of Two Feathers', make a list of the birds in the story and find some facts out about them.	Make a bird feeder for your garden. What you will need: Toilet roll tube, peanut butter, bird seeds, string, plate and knife. Firstly, attach the string to the tube. After, use the knife to spread the peanut butter all over the cardboard tube. Next place the bird seeds on a plate. Then roll the tube around the plate trying to cover it as much as possible. Place your bird feeder in your garden.
Describe an animal and get your grown up or siblings to guess which animal you're describing. Take it in turns so you also have the guess the animal.	Write a list of animals people keep as pets. Which one would you like? Why?	Find the names of animals that have paws, claws and whiskers. Make a list and categories them into the 3 categories.
