

We want to tell you about our Walking Bus.

What is a Walking Bus?

- It is a safe, fun and healthy way to travel to school.
- It is a group of children walking to school with parents/adults/volunteers in an organised way.

What are the benefits?

- Children arrive at school alert and ready for the day ahead.
- Walking is a healthy form of exercise.
- Improves road safety skills.
- Children learn about the weather changes and experience the seasons in an interactive way.
- Saves time for parents who may have younger children at home or work commitments.
- Helps address lateness for school

What do parents need to do?

Make sure your child is ready to be collected at the given time. We will not wait if you are late!

Complete the contact details and medical form and make sure we know of any changes immediately.

Make sure you contact the school at the earliest opportunity or by 7.30am on the morning if your child is ill or will not need to be collected.

After your child has been away tell us when they will be back on the bus.

How will it work?

- One adult will 'DRIVE' the bus, leading the way. They will have a register and emergency contact details.
- The other adult will be the 'CONDUCTOR' who manages children at the back of the bus.
- Your child will be collected at the agreed time. We will not be able to wait if you are late!
- The children and adults will wear high visibility jackets.
- The children will walk in pairs and younger children will hold hands with an adult/sibling.
- Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.
- Children will walk to school and be taken into 'Breakfast Club' for breakfast.
- They will be on the playground in time for the whistle.
- Good behaviour is essential.
- Inappropriate behaviour could result in them being taken off the bus.
- If you don't let us know your child is ill or absent from the bus on three separate occasions we will take your child off the bus.
